REGULAR CLASSES: The following classes are divided by Sex:

Puppy, 6 months & under 9 months	Puppy, 9 months & under 12 months
Twelve-to-Eighteen Months	Novice
Bred-by-Exhibitor*	American-Bred
Open	Winners

*All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be *individually registered* with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE ENTRIES: Classes divided by sex:

Veteran Class, 7 years of age or older. Spayed and neutered animals may be entered and shown in Veteran Classes at specialty shows. Only a 1st Place winner will be selected. All other exhibitors will receive a participation rosette.

Herding Titled Classes: Classes for dogs and bitches that have achieved an AKC Herding Title (HT, PT, HS, HI, HX, HCh). By virtue of winning this class the dog/bitch is entitled to compete for Best of Breed.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING MULTIPLE ENTRIES:

As the judge's decision in the following classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won in these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not be the owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: Same as above, except for the following two changes: substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog", and substitute "Produce" for "Get".

BRACE CLASS: The Brace class is for two dogs of the same breed having identical ownership. The dogs comprising the brace must be named at the time of the entry. Full particulars must be given for each dog on an individual entry form. If a dog that is to be part of a brace is entered in another class and entered as part of a brace, specify "Brace Class" in the Additional Classes section of the form and include the fee for the unit. If a dog is not entered in another class, specify "Brace Class Only" in the Dog Show Class section of the form and include a first dog entry fee.

CANCELLATIONS: There will be a \$5.00 cancellation fee per dog per show for dogs cancelled prior to the entry closing of a show.

***CREDIT CARD:** A nonrefundable processing fee thru Best In Show is a per dog per day whether mailed, emailed or faxed. Credit card number expiration date and cardholder name required on each entry form and the signature of the cardholder. We accept VISA, MasterCard, Discover and American Express. A Service Charge of \$20.00 to cover the cost of additional handling is assessed on **All Rejected** items for **any reason**. All payments for rejected items must be made by cash, money order or certified check. You may pay by mail only if payment is received in our office three days prior to the Show (do not send cash) or bring the total amount due to Show Secretaries table prior to judging. Armbands will be withheld if payment has not been received by 8 AM on the Day of the Show.

Entries must be in the office of Roberta Johnson, Show Secretary By NOON, WEDNESDAY, JULY 1, 2009

After the published closing time no entries will be accepted, cancelled, changed, substituted, corrected, completed or signed (exception Dog Show Rules, Ch. 11, Sec. 6) and no entry fees refunded. Telephoned telegraphed entries, conditional entries, and/or xeroxed entries without the AKC agreement on the back are not acceptable. All changes, completions and cancellations **MUST BE RECEIVED IN WRITING** before closing. Cancellations or Changes must include the dog's registration number, breed & name. Incomplete, illegible FAX Entries are not acceptable, and cannot be entered in the show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission. (AKC Rules, Ch. 11, Sec.4).

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This Show is governed by the American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC agreement on the back side of the entry blank in the Premium List. Additional Rules as follows:

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. Fees must accompany entries. This club and/or its superintendent assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This club and its superintendent assume no responsibility for the owner or the owner's agent entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
2. Entry fees will NOT be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of the entry fee for bitches in season; bitches entered for breed competition are eligible to be shown.
3. Declination of Entries. The Kennel Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Club or any official thereof.
4. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.
5. Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half hour before the start of any regular conformation judging at the Show.
6. There will be no refunds for duplicate entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
7. Owners/Agents are responsible for errors in making out entry forms. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published date.

JUDGING

1. Judging will start promptly. During the hours of judging, owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only to be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused.
2. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners or agents of the dog alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. There is no rule that requires the judge to wait for a late dog.
3. All dogs must be on leash at all times while on the show premises, except when in an exercise pen or in the obedience ring if offered.
4. All prizes will be awarded in the ring. The Club reserves the right to substitute any trophy with one of greater or equal value if conditions make it necessary. The show giving club and show secretary disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

LOSS OR DAMAGE

1. Management is not responsible for the loss or damage to, or death of any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
2. NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: All persons attending this show hereby waive any claim for damages against the show giving Club or its Members in the event a motor vehicle has to be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or improperly vented conditions. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.
3. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.

All rights to televise, video tape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. All persons and animals on the Showgrounds at any time while the Show is in progress, do by attending this show or participating therein, grant to the Club the right to photograph, televise, video tape, audiotape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent. The Kennel Club is not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at this show.

Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under The American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts, except that dogs engaged as a special attraction with American Kennel Club approval may also be present.

There shall be no benching, nor offering for sale or breeding dogs.
