GRAND CHAMPION SELECT

When quality warrants, after BOB and BOS are awarded. A Select Dog (SD) and Select Bitch (SB) maybe chosen from the remaining Champions(Non-Regular Class winners that are Champions and Qualify for BOB are eligible-WD or WB are not eligible (AKC Dog Show Rules Chapter 3, Section 14 Effective 5/12/10)

AWARDS OF MERIT

At the conclusion of the Best of Breed Judging, the judge may at their discretion, award up to five (5) of the specials entry. The Judge is not obligated to award any Awards of Merit, if he feels there are not any dogs or bitches in competition, worthy of this award. All dogs competing in the Best of Breed competition are eligible for this award, with the exception of the Best of Breed.

AMATEUR OWNER HANDLER ELIGIBILITY

For dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog and is limited to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional handle AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13). *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.*

BEST BRED-BY and BBE ELIGIBILITY

All dogs entered in the Bred-By class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class. Any entry in the Bred-By-Exhibitor classes that is awarded Best Of Breed or Best Of Winners would automatically be Best Bred-By Exhibitor. Only the dog or bitch not defeated in Bred-By-Exhibitor are eligible for the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor competition.

BEST PUPPY

Any entry in the puppy classes that is awarded Best Of Breed or Best Of Winners would automatically be Best Puppy. Only dogs not defeated in a puppy class are eligible for Best Puppy competition.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veteran Class-7 years of age and older. Only a first place winner will be selected. All other exhibitors will receive a participation rosette.
Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches may compete in the Veterans Classes only at independent specialties and by virtue of winning the class may compete for Best Of Breed. (AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 14, Section B.)

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Brace Class -The Brace Class is for two dogs of the same breed having identical ownership. The dogs comprising the brace must be named at the time of entry. Full particulars must be give for each dog on an individual entry form. If a dog that is to be part of a brace is entered in another class and entered as a part of a brace, specify "Brace Class" in the Additional Classes section of the form and include the "additional class" fee for the unit. If a dog is not entered in another class, specify "Brace Class Only" in the Dog Show Class section of the form and pay the first dog entry fee.
